A LETTER FROM THE VP of Advancement & Alumni Relations

The 2019-20 fiscal year was unquestionably a year of change.

- Our first formal capital campaign took place this past year. Building an appropriate facility for the new School of Health Professions on the first floor of the Mack (Library) Building was needed, anticipated and then constructed and completed. Unifying these majors under one roof creates not just a physical expansion of classroom and lab spaces but also collaboration among disciplines, enrollment growth, enhanced recruitment and a stronger BJU brand. This new area will provide our health professions students with up-to-date, intuitive spaces for years to come.
 - I am pleased to announce another significant milestone—a new financial fundraising mark of \$8.66 million! 3,275 BJU alumni and friends (including 951 President’s Society members) shared in our mission through support of our students and the student experience at a higher level than ever before—and we are grateful. In addition, we’re thankful for our 572 Heritage Society members who are continuing to provide for BJU’s future through their estates. Thank you all for your support!
 - COVID-19 presented a new opportunity for BJU. In early March, BJU made the decision to move classes to an online learning environment. This critical decision was important in protecting the university community from the threat of the virus. Online learning proved that BJU could provide a world class Christian education away from campus. In April, President Pettit announced the creation of the COVID-19 Student Emergency Grant that would provide additional funding to students who have experienced financial hardship as a result of the Coronavirus.

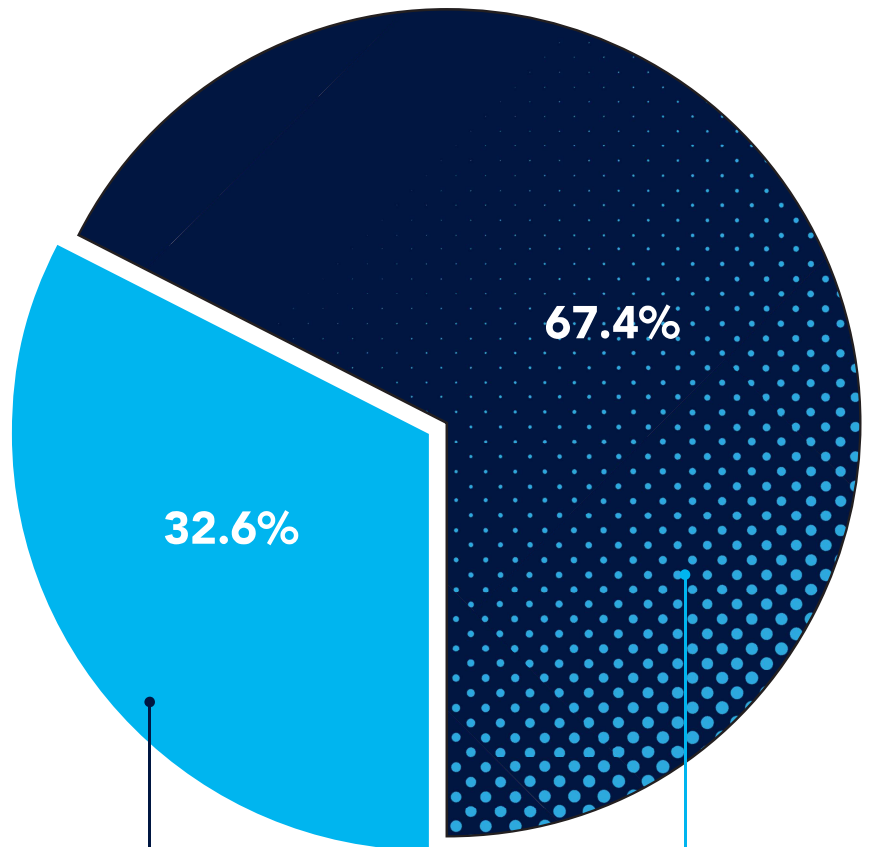
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This scholarship continues Mrs. Jones' legacy of helping women students who are children or grandchildren of alumni and are in dire need. Since launching this fund in February 2019, \$338,000 has been raised, well exceeding the \$250,000 goal.

S&E Endowment Update

- **SITS** (Summer Institute in Teaching Science) completed its 15th year in 2019. Seventeen professors participated in the summer 2019 program, which helps faculty enhance their courses.
- Our Cancer Research Director endowed chair is Dr. Steve Figard, who came to BJU with experience as a research biochemist and lead scientist at Abbott Laboratories.
- Our Biology RIU (Research Immersion Undergraduates) program is headed by Dr. Steve Figard, and our Chemistry RIU program is headed by Dr. Robert Lee. RIU enables students to spend summers in full-time research.
- This year, **\$139,691** was raised for the Science & Engineering Endowment Fund!

Bridge Scholars Program

The Bridge Scholars Program assists BJU's American minority students through additional funding to bridge the gap between institutional/federal/state scholarships and their remaining financial need. Currently, 44 students are attending BJU under the Bridge Scholars Program.



Bruins Foundation

The Bruins Foundation funds BJU's intercollegiate athletics program as they use sports as a platform for ministry. Bruins athletics exists to glorify God by promoting unity, pursuing competitive excellence, mentoring students and providing ministry opportunities. **This year, 227 donors gave \$104,916 to Bruins athletics.**

We are pleased to announce that in late June the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) approved BJU as a provisional Division III member. BJU enters provisional status in September, which begins a three-year evaluation and review period. BJU will continue its affiliation with the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA).

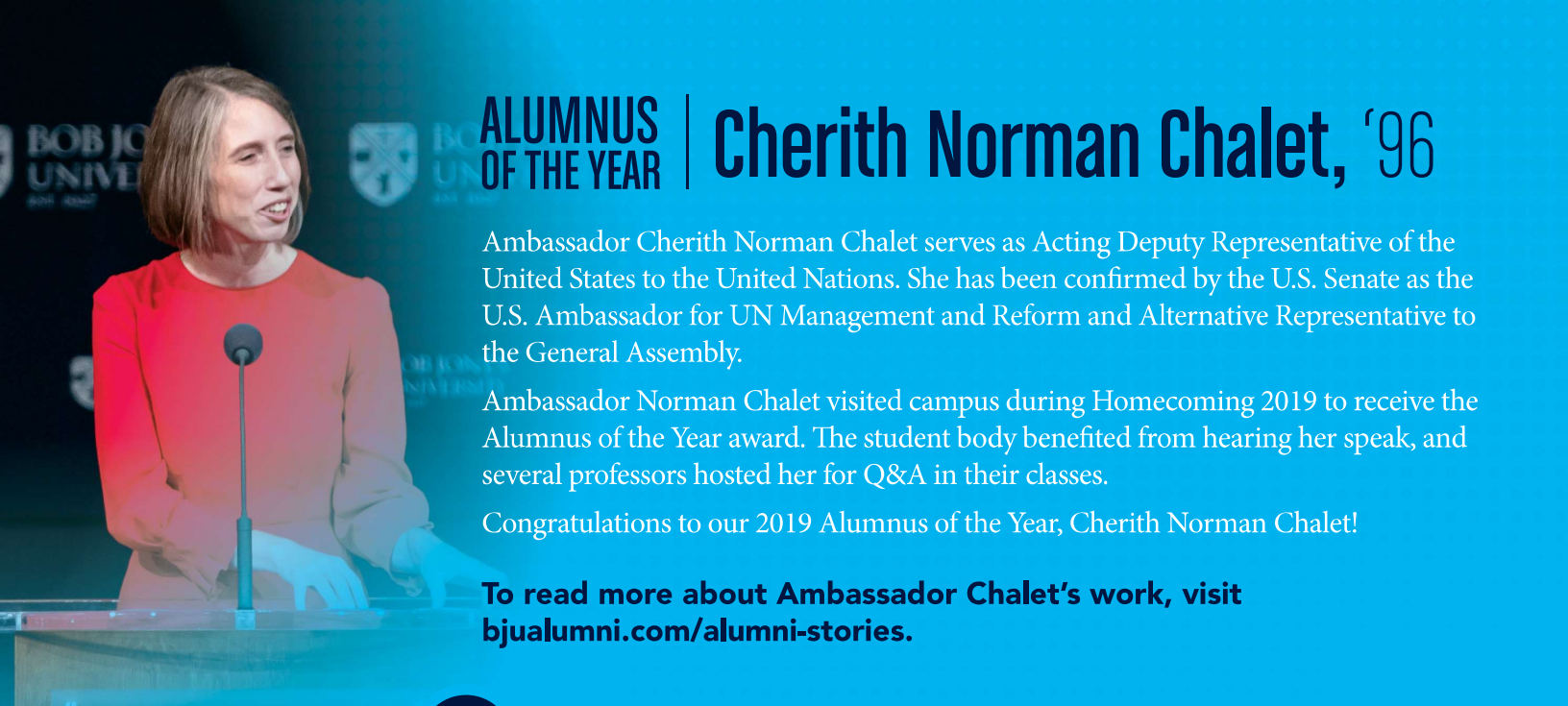


Patron of the Arts

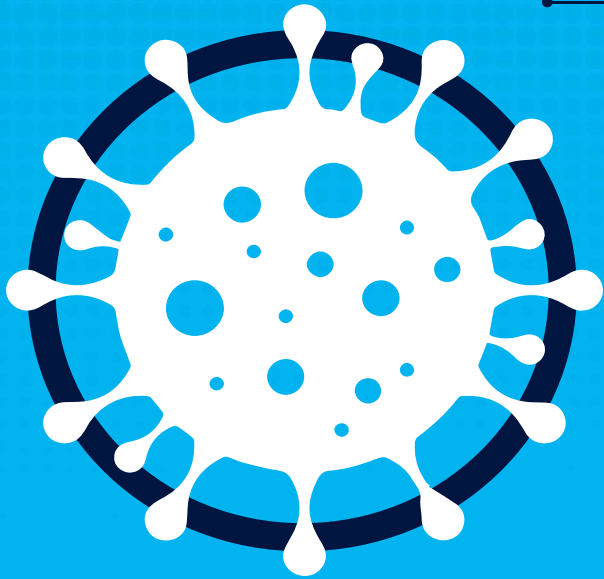

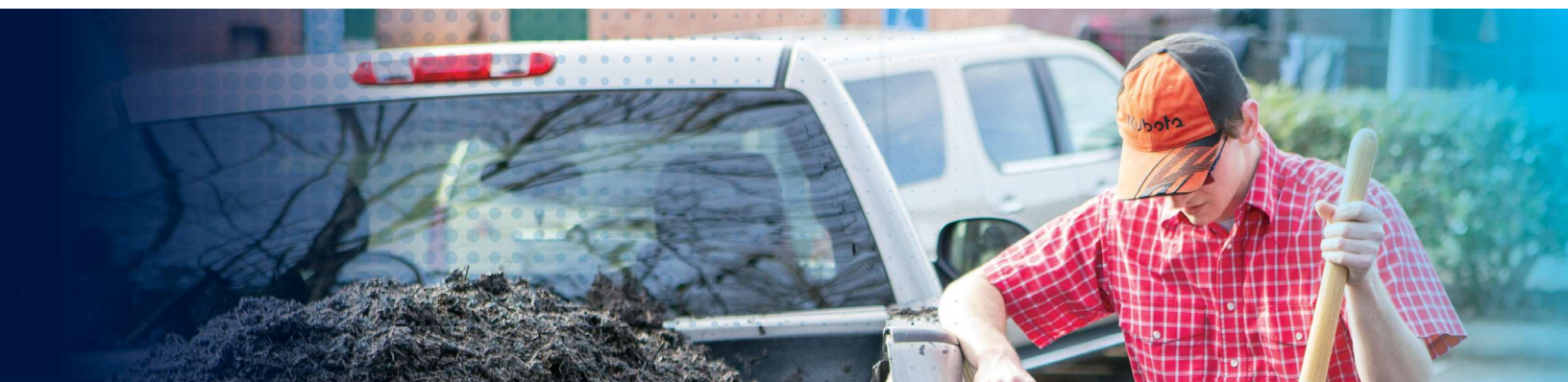
Since launching in April 2020, faithful donors have given over \$550,000 from more than 700 alumni & friends.

MARVELL LARECHE, '19 Your donations are saving lives

A 2019 graduate of the nursing program, Marvell Lareche works in the cardiovascular ICU at Greenville Memorial Hospital and has already seen the benefit of his BJU education. From hospital residency to night-shifts, Marvell can trace the strength of the nursing program in his own experience. “I didn’t realize how critical [the Nursing program] was until I met grads from other schools,” he says. His residency training reinforced what he had learned as a student, while those from other programs seemed less prepared in some areas. He credits the nursing faculty for encouraging students to “not only succeed on paper, but [to] really know the information.” At the cardiovascular ICU, Marvell uses the critical thinking he developed at BJU to care for his heart patients, having learned to see the whole person and not only the stats on the monitor.

BJU’s emphasis on God has been foundational during busy shifts, he says. And as the novel coronavirus pandemic has persisted, Marvell encourages continued prayer and “genuine love and support” for one another. While he now begins every shift with additional safety protocols, one thing has stayed the same: Marvell is well prepared to love his patients and serve his community for Christ’s sake.
